The Call for Abstracts for the TAC Annual Scientific Meeting and Conference has been out since July. Do you have something to share?

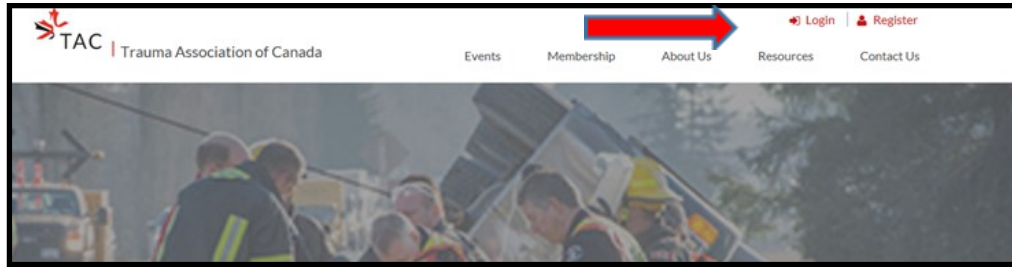

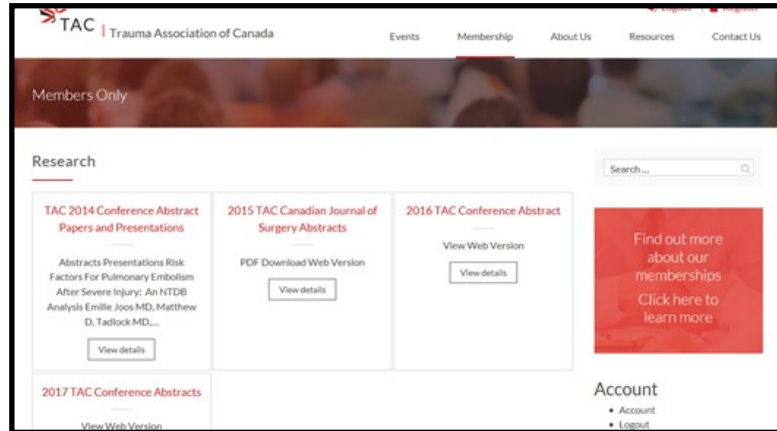

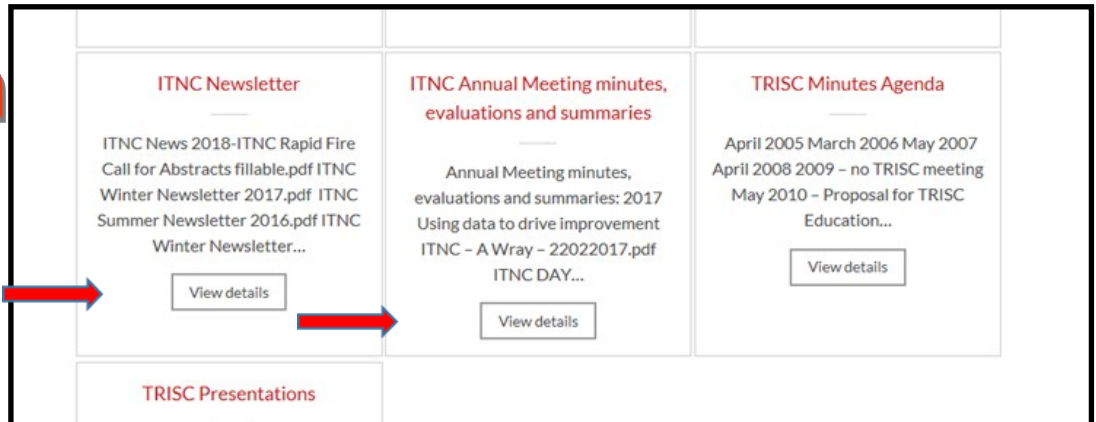
