TAC Members Policy

Classes and Conditions of Membership

Under the **TAC General Operating Bylaw No. 1:**

"There shall be one (1) class of Members in the Association. The Board of Directors of the Association may, by resolution, approve the admission of the Members of the Association. Members may also be admitted in such other manner as may be prescribed by the Board by resolution."

Members of TAC

Membership in the Association shall be available only to:

1. **Medical Doctors (includes Fellows), PhDs** holding a licence to practice from the appropriate certifying body in Canada;
2. **Nurses (RNs, NPs, CNS), Paramedics & other Allied Health Professionals** holding a licence to practice from the appropriate regulatory or certifying body in Canada;
3. **Data Registry Specialists ; Other Non-medical professional individuals or groups** determined by the Board of Directors as meeting the threshold for membership within Canada (e.g. **Health Information Specialists, Injury Prevention Specialists etc**)
4. Membership may be further subdivided into categories of membership as described in the Association's Operating Policies

Member Fees

The following fee structure applies to the Member Categories:

Medical Doctors: **\$200.00**

Fellows: **\$200.00**

PhDs : **\$200.00**

Nurses (RNs, NPs,CNS), Paramedics & Other Allied Health Professionals **\$125.00**

Data Registry Specialists and other Non-Medical Professional Individuals or Groups: **\$125.00**

Other categories: **\$125.00**

The Board of Directors reserves the exclusive right to accept or reject any application for Member status. Should an application be rejected, the submitted Member fee will be returned to the unsuccessful applicant.
