I am pleased to announce an exciting trauma course, ASSET (Advanced Surgical Skills for Exposure in Trauma), on Friday April 26, 2019 at CSTAR (Canadian Surgical Technologies & Advanced Robotics), University Hospital, London Health Sciences Centre in London, Ontario.

This course was developed by the Surgical Skills Subcommittee of the Committee on Trauma, American College of Surgeons. It is a one day cadaveric based course that aims to teach surgical exposure of critical anatomic structures in the neck, thorax, abdomen and pelvis as well as upper and lower extremities. Each section begins with a short case-based overview, followed by a hands-on exposure performed by students under the guidance of faculty. The student to faculty ratio is low, allowing extensive faculty guidance and interaction with students.

The course is ideally suited for chief residents, surgical fellows and practicing surgeons. It really is a unique, excellent course that will allow participants to familiarize themselves with essential lifesaving anatomic exposures.
