A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS major trauma or injury is the principal cause of death for people under 45 years of age in Canada, and falls and motor vehicle-related injuries are the main causes of moderate-to-severe injury hospitalizations in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS of the 750 000 British Columbians injured each year, about 1 500 die, 9 000 suffer permanent disability and 30 000 are hospitalized; an estimated 70 000 potential years of life are lost; and the yearly cost of injury exceeds \$4.5 billion in British Columbia and exceeds \$31.4 billion nationally in 2021 dollars, and

WHEREAS the mission of Trauma Services BC, a program of the Provincial Health Services Authority, is to ensure the optimal performance of the provincial trauma system, and its long-term vision is for an integrated system of injury care, control and prevention strategies that results in British Columbia having the lowest burden of injury in North America, and

WHEREAS specialized health care providers are trained and certified to provide expert trauma care across the health care continuum, from pre-hospital or paramedicine through emergency care, critical care and surgical or medical specialties to rehabilitation and community integration, and

WHEREAS all British Columbians have an equal right to education on and awareness of injury care, control and prevention strategies, and

WHEREAS Trauma Awareness Week is an opportunity to build public awareness of the impacts of traumatic injury and to educate on prevention strategies;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 11 to 17, 2021, shall be known as

“Trauma Awareness Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.


